	<p>Item Nos. 01 to 08</p> <p>March 19, 2018 A</p>	<p>In pursuance to the statement made on behalf of the Delhi Jal Board regarding to drying up of the river due to lack of sufficient water release into it on 16th March, 2018 we have passed an order directing the State of Haryana and all concerned to file the response. The State of Haryana has filed an Affidavit to the factual aspect referred to in the report the DJB would like to traverse. However, in the meantime we are of the opinion that certain additional statics is necessary for proper appreciation of the grounds urged before the Tribunal. Therefore, there shall be an inspection of Reservoir/ barrage at Tajewala, Wazirabad and Okhla by the team of Members from the Irrigation Department, Union of India, Upper Yamuna River Board and Irrigation Department of State of Haryana and NCT of Delhi and Central Pollution Control Board shall be involved in the said joint inspection who will be the nodal agency for coordination.</p> <p>The teams shall inspect the said barrage/ reservoirs and give opinion as to what is the quantity of water release for the past one month from the said Barrage and whether there is any extraction of water from these Barrage by anybody and the Okhla, River. We are confine it to river only.</p> <p>The report be filed by 22nd March, 2018.
