	<p> Item No. 39 to 41 April 26, 2017 ss </p>	<p> In furtherance to our order dated 12th April, 2017, the Chamber Meeting has been held today where the senior officers from various stakeholders including consultant and professors are present. It has been informed to the Tribunal that there has been sufficient progress in the execution of the Judgment of the Tribunal and awarding of work for execution thereto. It is stated that there are in all 14 STP projects out of which 7 are to be completed by the Delhi Jal Board with its own fund. The officers have stated that all the 7 STP projects, the work order has been issued to M/s. Larsen & Toubro whose representative if present before the Tribunal and confirms the same. The representative of M/s. L&T shall submit a complete Action Plan within two weeks from today, in relation to these projects and also submit that how early the projects can be completed. </p> <p> With regard to the remaining 7 projects the tenders have already been invited and even works have been awarded, however, financial assistance from Namami Gange is awaited. Even these 7 projects also have been awarded to M/s. L&T. The directions aforesaid shall be </p>

	<p>Item No. 39 to 41</p> <p>April 26, 2017</p> <p>ss</p>	<p>followed by them even in this part of the project as well.</p> <p>On behalf of Namami Gange we are informed that that entire reappraisal process has been completed and the meeting which was fixed has been now adjourned to first week of May, 2017 and the projects would be given clearance and funds accordingly be released. No further step is required to be taken by the Namami Gange in this behalf. The Engineer Member from Delhi Development Authority has stated that the projects with the Delhi Development Authority have already been cleared by the Delhi Development Authority and sent to the Ministry of Urban Development for grant of approval and sanctioning of fund.</p> <p>The Director, Urban Development has stated that the projects have already been approved by the Committee however, they are waiting for final approval from the Minister, Urban Development for which file has already been submitted to the Minister and is likely to be cleared very shortly. The executing agency, Delhi Jal Board submits that this completes the entire project of Phase-I relating to Delhi Gate drain and Najafgarh Drain in terms of the Judgment of the Tribunal. Delhi Gate drain receives the Sewage/Effluent to the extent of 20 MGD out of this nearly 2 to 4 MGD is diverted to the Okhla STP for treatment. However, the remaining discharge is treated by two different Plants of 15 MGD and 2.2 MGD.</p> <p>We direct that the work of entire Phase-I project under the judgment should commence without any further delay. It shall be obligatory upon any of the stakeholders to approach to the Tribunal if there is any</p>

We would not permit any of the stakeholders and the department present before us, in this meeting to take an excuse, if summoned for non-compliance in future. We do hope that all agencies will discharge their obligations for compliance without delay and default.</p> <p>We direct the joint inspection team of Central Pollution Control Board, Delhi Pollution Control Committee and the nominee of the IIT, Roorkee to inspect the STP at Delhi Gate drain as well as the Okhla STP plant and report to the Tribunal with regard to functioning of these plants as well as analysis of the effluent samples before the next date of hearing.</p> <p>We direct, the joint inspection team to analyse samples for Nitrate and Phosphate.</p> <p>List these matters tomorrow i.e. on 27th April, 2017.</p> <p>.....,CP (Swatanter Kumar)</p> <p>.....,JM (Dr. Jawad Rahim)</p> <p>.....,JM (Raghuvendra S.
