	<p>Item Nos. 15-17</p> <p>July 28, 2015</p>	<p>In furtherance to our previous order Additional Chief Secretary, Irrigation and Additional Chief Secretary, Urban Local Bodies are present. They have informed and given a clear undertaking to the Tribunal that :-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ten cumecs water would be continued to be discharged at Hathnikund. However, they may have some difficulty in the lean season to maintain 10 cumecs flow in the River Yamuna from Hathnikund to Wazirabad, for which they may be granted liberty to file application. <p style="text-align: center;">Since, the recommendation of the Principal Committee in this behalf is awaited, we grant liberty to State of Haryana to file such application. Till variation/clear direction of the Tribunal, order already passed shall continue in full force.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. They submit that steps are being taken to block any discharge into the Nazafgarh Drain from Leg-1 and the exercise would be completed by August, 2015 in terms of earlier order of the Tribunal. 3. Tender for construction of CETPs/STPs at Leg-2 as where it joins Nazafgarh drain, have already been invited and work would be executed expeditiously. However, it is stated that the notification for acquiring land under the provisions of the new Land Acquisition Act is under preparation and would be issued within one week from today. <p>As far as setting up of CETPs and STPs, to ensure</p>

that either they have no discharge by recycling of the treated water or wherever it is necessary, the release from CETPs and STPs would be strictly in accordance with the prescribed parameters. This would be from all the five points in the State of Haryana where the main drain joins river Yamuna that is at Yamuna Nagar-Jagadari, Karnal, Panipat, Sonapat-Samalkha and Kundli.

Let the Maps of the drainage network, location of CETP/STP, the distance between the last CETP/STP on the drain upto its confluence with river Yamuna, and extent of industrial and residential area covered by each STP/CETP and even the proposed development in that area, be submitted to the Tribunal within one week from today. We have also been informed on behalf of the State of Haryana on instruction of senior officers that by 2017, all the CETPs and STPs would be established properly, water would be recycled for minimum discharge into the river Yamuna which will not contain any pollutants. They shall also identify adequacy of each of the CETP and STP to handle effluent load.
